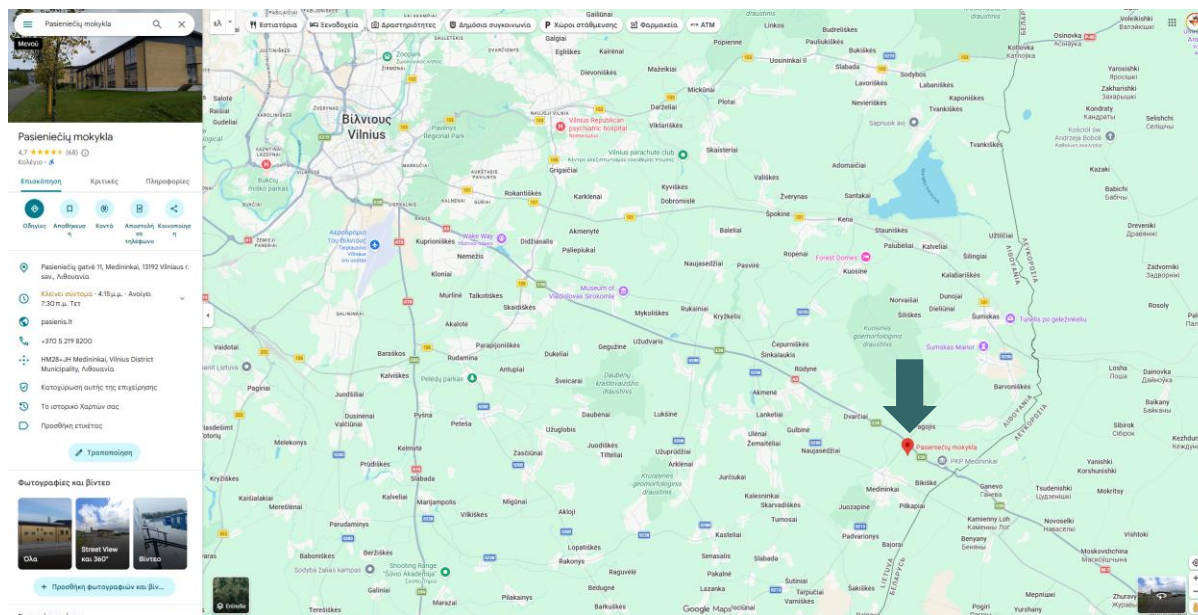

## Reaching Vilnius City Center from Vilnius Airport (VNO)

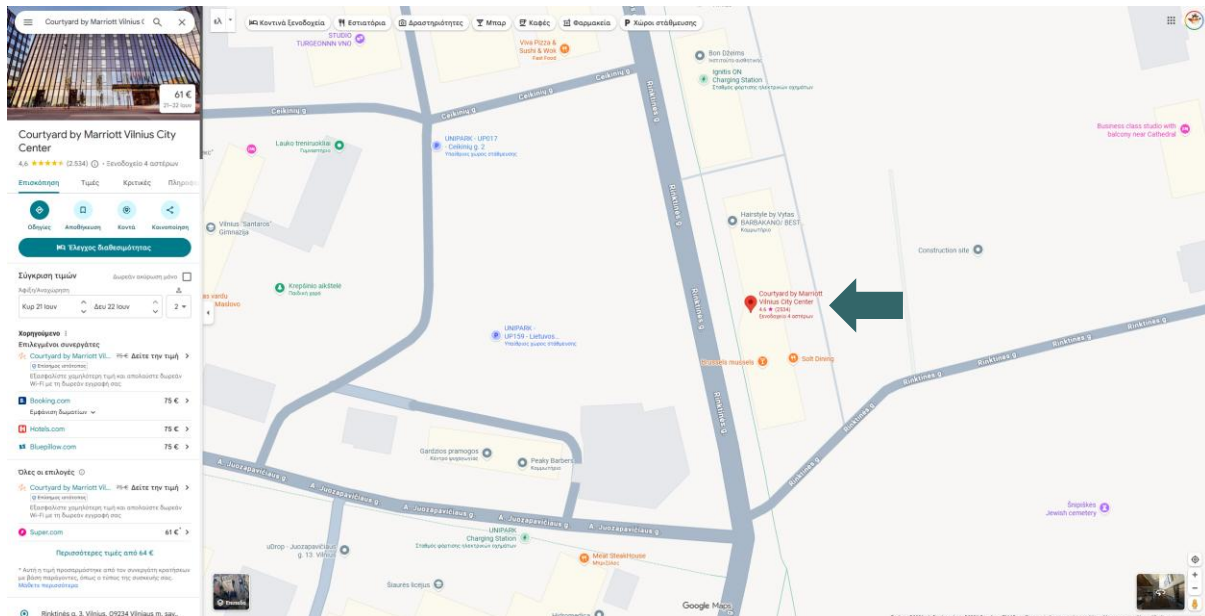
- **By Bolt/Taxi:** Taking a Bolt – cheapest option compared with a taxi – is the fastest way to reach the center of Vilnius. Upon your arrival and when exiting M.K. Čiurlionis – Vilnius (VNO) International Airport, you will find a designated taxi area with many available vehicles. The estimated travel time to the hotel is 20–30 minutes, depending on traffic conditions. Please note that the cost is relatively high (~10–30 EUR) and may vary depending on time of day/night.
- **By public transport** (duration: ~ 30–45 minutes): Upon arrival at M.K. Čiurlionis – Vilnius (VNO) International Airport, and once you exit the terminal at ground level, you will find a bus stop just one minute away. From there, there are two options:
  - Bus Nr. 3G
  - Bus Nr. 88

A single journey costs €1.20 per person. You can pay on the bus by tapping a contactless payment card at the validator.

## Reaching Venue from Vilnius City Center

VSAT will provide a special bus service from the hotel (**Courtyard by Marriott Vilnius City Center**) to the **FALCON event**, and at the end of the day from Medininkai back to the hotel.
